A title awarded to a former active member of Job's Daughters International



WHO Are Majority Members?

Each member of Job's Daughters in good standing with her Bethel shall become a Majority Member:

- upon becoming twenty (20) years of age, or
- when married under the age.



EVIDENCE of Majority Membership

Each qualifying Daughter shall immediately receive, at no cost, a Certificate of Majority Membership (Form 162).



RESPONSIBLITIES

A Majority Member shall:

- keep her Bethel informed of any change in her name and address, and

PRIVILEGES

A Majority Member:

- may receive the Majority Degree at such time as may be convenient,
- is entitled to all the rights and privileges of an active member except voting and holding office,
- shall be exempt from further payment of dues,
- when asked, may serve as an installing officer, not the Installing Officer, of her Bethel, or of another Bethel with approval of the Executive Members of the Bethel's Guardian Council.
- may, if never married, be appointed to fill the Honored Queen's station should it become vacant and no Past Honored Queen be available.
- may give Honors only in a closed meeting,
- may assume the attitude of prayer while the Chaplain is at the Altar,
- may vouch for a Daughter's membership in the Order.
- may take part in the Purging Ceremony,
- may debate questions arising in meetings of her Bethel,
- may enter the Messengers' semicircle when entering and retiring from a Bethel session,
- may be privileged occasionally to fill an office for an absentee.
- may be recognized and given an appropriate welcome at Bethel meetings,
- may be appointed to serve on a Bethel Guardian Council without further evidence of Masonic relationship (if at least twenty (20) years of age).
